WHO SHOULD APPLY?

Faculty members from established college and university hospitality programs at accredited, four-year schools are invited to apply for The Club Foundation Faculty Internship.

CRITERIA

Candidates must demonstrate strong evidence of their interest in private club management and in the development of a club management curriculum. Preferably, candidates will have demonstrated experience teaching course(s) related to club management at the undergraduate or graduate level or be actively involved in teaching in CMAA-sponsored programs, such as the Business Management Institute.

FACULTY INTERNSHIP PROGRAM SCHEDULE

- Faculty Interns will complete an extensive orientation in conjunction with the CMAA Leadership Legislative Conference (LLC). Interns will stay at the hotel where this conference is held and will be encouraged to attend conference education sessions. In addition, interns will visit two or more private clubs during LLC.
- The Faculty Interns will then be required to complete an internship of a minimum of 40 hours at a private club in their area. This component of the internship can be concentrated in just one club or the 40 hours can be divided among several clubs – this is left to the discretion of the Faculty Intern.
- The Club Foundation Faculty Internships will be completed by **May 1, 2022**, and Interns will be required to summarize their experiences in writing, due by **August 31, 2022**. These may be published in a CMAA publication.

EXPENSES COVERED BY THE CLUB FOUNDATION

- Travel to/from Orientation Weekend (held in conjunction with the Legislative/Leadership Conference).
- Hotel accommodations at the Legislative/Leadership Conference
- Mileage reimbursements (50 cents per mile) for visits to clubs to complete the 40 hours of hands-on experience.

REQUIREMENTS FOR APPLICATION SUBMISSION

- 1) Complete and submit an application by **May 1, 2021**.
- 2) Submit an essay addressing the following components:
 - Your current involvement with and/or knowledge of private club management;
 - The hospitality curriculum currently offered at your college/university including the courses geared specifically to club management;
 - Your reasons for seeking an internship from The Club Foundation;
 - Why you believe your participation as a Faculty Intern would benefit the current curriculum at your school or your role as a faculty member in CMAA-sponsored programs such as the Business Management Institute;
 - Why you would like to incorporate a more in-depth club management curriculum at your school; and
 - Availability of private clubs in your geographic area for the hands-on experience component of The Club Foundation Faculty Internship.
- 3) Enclose a copy of your hospitality school's course offerings for the current academic year.
- 4) Provide a letter from your dean or department head supporting your desire to participate in the Faculty Internship Program.
- 5) Enclose a current resume.

NOTE: Any application that does not include all of the listed requirements will not be considered for The Club Foundation Faculty Internship.
